A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE IN THE STATE OF ALASKA, DIVISION OF COMMUNITY ADVOCACY, MULTI-USE FACILITIES' REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR A GRANT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A GIRDWOOD COMMUNITY CENTER AND LIBRARY, AND COMMITTING TO FACILITY OPERATION.

WHEREAS, the Girdwood Board of Supervisors adopted a resolution in support of a grant application to the Denali Commission to partially fund a Multi-Use Facility for a Girdwood Community Center and Library;

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Assembly supports the resolution adopted by the Girdwood Board of Supervisors to participate in a grant program to provide partial funding for construction of a Multi-Use Facility in Girdwood; now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

- The Anchorage Assembly endorses the participation of the Municipality in a grant proposal for a Multi-Use Facility in Girdwood for a community center and library, commits to fulfilling the responsibilities and duties assigned to the Municipality in the proposal;
- 2. The Municipality commits to sustaining the facility and the programs to be offered within it;
- 3. The Municipality commits to an "open-door" policy to assure the facility will provide service to all who seek and can pay for such services;
- 4. The Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all documents required for granting and managing funds on behalf of this project in conformance with all requirements set by the Denali Commission and the State of Alaska; and

 5. The Mayor, or his designee, is also authorized to execute subsequent amendments to the grant agreement to provide for adjustments to the project within the scope of services or tasks, based on the needs of the project.
