A RESOLUTION APPROVING CONSTRUCTION OF THE EAGLE LOT 18A (S05-010) SANITARY SEWER LINE EXTENSION, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EVENTUAL ASSESSMENT AGAINST BENEFITED PROPERTY.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

WHEREAS, Alaska State Statute 42.05.385 and AMC 19.80.010(B) mandate that when a sanitary sewer line extension will create any charge, or assessment, against the adjacent property, the sanitary sewer line extension may not be constructed unless the legislative body of each municipality through which the extension passes has approved the extension.

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) has received application from a Developer to extend a sanitary sewer line under AWWU's sewer main extension agreement program to serve property along Mausel Street known as Lot 18A, Eagle Subdivision.

WHEREAS, the extension of the sanitary sewer line will specially benefit and provide sanitary sewer service to an additional six (6) properties (reimbursable properties), and in doing so, will create potential assessments against them.

NOW THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

- **SECTION 1.** It is in the best interests of the community that said sanitary sewer line extension proceed.
- **SECTION 2.** The Developer shall keep, and provide to the AWWU, an accurate account of all costs of the sanitary sewer line improvements.
- **SECTION 3.** Approximate costs for sanitary sewer line construction have been provided by the Developer and these costs are allocated to each specially benefited parcel, as estimated on the attached sanitary sewer assessment roll per the AWWU Wastewater Tariff.

SECTION 4. After the sanitary sewer line improvements have been completed and AWWU has received and approved the Developer's record drawings and certified project costs for the improvements, the Mayor shall cause the computation of all applicable assessment charges. At such time as each of the six reimbursable properties cited on the attached assessment roll connect to the sanitary sewer line, the respective pro-rata charge, or assessment, for the sanitary sewer line shall be levied in accordance with Municipal Codes and the AWWU Wastewater Utility Tariff in effect at the time the assessment is levied.

SECTION 5. A Special Assessment Collection Charge, as authorized in Rule 7.4 of the Sewer Utility Tariff, in effect at the time the assessment is levied, will be charged to those properties identified in this resolution.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.




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

Subject: Approval of Eagle Lot 18A Sanitary Sewer Line Extension S05-010 and Providing for Assessment of Benefiting Properties at the Time of Service Connection.

AMC 19.80.010(B) and AS 42.05.385 require Assembly approval to construct a sanitary sewer line extension where the extension will create, or has the potential to create, any charges or assessments against the adjacent properties. A public hearing is required prior to Assembly action.

A developer plans to construct a sanitary sewer line extension in the Eagle River community along Mausel Street from Mammoth Court south to Artillery Road. The sanitary sewer line extension will be for the purpose of benefiting the developer's parcel and in doing so, will also benefit six (6) other parcels which currently lack public sanitary sewer service. The developer will fund and pay expenses to complete the water line extension.

The other six properties benefiting from the proposed construction are identified on the proposed assessment roll, which is made a part of the resolution carried by this memorandum. As each property seeks connection, the parcel's pro-rata share of assessable sanitary sewer line costs will be presented to the Assembly for confirmation of levy action in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility's Wastewater Tariff in effect at the time of connection.

Owners of benefited property were notified of the estimated project cost, and their individual property's estimated cost allocation, by mail on March 22, 2005. There was also a public meeting with property owners on April 4, 2005 at AWWU's office.

The passage of this resolution will have no fiscal impact on Municipal owned parcels.

THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS THE ASSEMBLY APPROVE THE SANITARY SEWER LINE EXTENSION TO EAGLE SUBDIVISION, LOT 18A.
