A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING DIANA PEARCY FOR HER 17 YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE.

WHEREAS, Diana Pearcy began her employment with the Municipality of Anchorage in 1988 as the finance manager of Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility (AWWU) and was appointed in March 2004 as the Director of the Office of Management and Budget for the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, Diana was an early visionary and strong leader in the development of an employee involvement culture at AWWU, and she led in the design and completion of numerous cost-saving efficiency schemes, such as the implementation of PeopleSoft, the MOA-AWWU Procurement Card pilot project, and the electronic time card project; and

WHEREAS, Diana helped to strengthen AWWU's financial integrity, increased net incomes and equity, decreased debt, improved the bond rating, oversaw the first sale of wastewater revenue bonds, and protected customer interests with no rate increase in 12 years and one rate decrease; and

WHEREAS, Diana helped to rewrite of State of Alaska statutes and regulations for the Clean Water and Safe Drinking Water revolving loan programs, saving AWWU substantial monies, and she has been active in financial planning and accounting for the Alaska Chapter of the American Red Cross, serving for 16 years on various boards and committees, as Alaska State Chair from 1998-2000, and a member of the National American Red Cross Nominations Committee; and

WHEREAS, Diana has lent her considerable financial expertise to the Anchorage Parking Authority as Treasurer, and she has participated in fundraising and other activities for the March of Dimes, Bayshore PTA, West Dimond Little League, Big Dippers and Glacier's Edge Precisions Drill Teams.
