WHEREAS, the Math Olympiad program serves over 4,000 American teams with 100,000 students and 1,800 teams with 35,000 students in other countries and, since 1979, it has provided challenging, thought-provoking problems that stretch the abilities of students in grades four through eight and has required them to demonstrate a deep understanding of mathematical concepts; and

WHEREAS, seven students on the Kincaid team, Kyle Moore, Jake Alward, Ellie Simpson, Caleb Crockett, Brandon Markson, Sagan Osborne, and Ryan Watson, placed in the top half of the Math Olympiad standings; three of the Kincaid team, Ryan Watson, Mike Sedor and Jake Alward, scored perfect scores on separate contests. a feat claimed by only two percent of the contestants in this international contest: Ellie Simpson gained recognition as high point female and high point fifth grader and Math Derby Captain; Kyle Moore was the team's top scorer and was awarded the Olympiad Silver Pin for placing in the top ten percent internationally; and
