SUBJECT: Appropriation of Forty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$47,000) to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) Under a State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) with the Municipality of Anchorage for Bicycle/Pedestrian Transportation Coordination.

An Assembly Resolution is requested to appropriate forty-seven thousand dollars (\$47,000) to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) managed by the Municipal Traffic Department under a State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) with the Municipality of Anchorage for Bicycle/Pedestrian Transportation Coordination. The State of Alaska TORA originates from funds programmed in the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and appropriated by the Legislature for this particular purpose.

The scope of services for Bicycle/Pedestrian Transportation Coordination includes: public safety education campaigns and contract services; training; route marking; preparation of maps, brochures, and interpretive materials. Additional allowable duties include serving as staff to the Trails Advisory Committee, plans review of federally funded bike/pedestrian facilities, monitoring the trail count program, and preparation of updates for the Municipality's Areawide Trails Plan.
