A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT TO FILE FOR A FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION SECTION 5303 METROPOLITAN PLANNING PROGRAM GRANT, ENTER INTO A TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND FORTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$229,343) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, STATE OF ALASKA, AND TO APPROPRIATE THESE FUNDS ALONG WITH FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$57,336) FOR

REQUIRED LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT'S 2005 OPERATING BUDGET TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) FOR FINANCING OF THE TRANSIT PLANNING

PROGRAM

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

WHEREAS, the United States Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make grants for Public Transportation planning programs:

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the Municipality of Anchorage, including the provision by it of a local share of project costs.

WHEREAS, it is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, the Municipality gives assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder:

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Municipality of Anchorage that minority business enterprises are utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority business shall have the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Mayor or Municipal Manager, or such other person as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to execute and file applications on behalf of the Municipality of Anchorage with the State of Alaska to aid in the financing of planning assistance projects pursuant to section 5303 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.

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Section 2. That the Mayor or the Municipal Manager, or such other person as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to execute and file with such applications an assurance or other document required by the United States Department of Transportation effectuating the purpose of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

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Section 3. That the Mayor or the Municipal Manager, or such other person as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative minority business policies in connection with this application's program of projects.

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Section 4. That the Mayor or the Municipal Manager, or such other person as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to furnish such additional information as the State of Alaska may require in connection with this application's program of projects.

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Section 5. That the Mayor or the Municipal Manager, or such other person or persons as the Mayor or Municipal Manager designates, is authorized to enter into a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) between the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for the financing of the Transit Planning Program.

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Section 6. That the sum of two hundred twenty-nine thousand three hundred and forty-three dollars (\$229,343) is appropriated as a grant from the Alaska Department of Public Transportation and Public Facilities, when awarded, to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) for the financing of the Transit Planning Program.

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Section 7. That the sum of fifty-seven thousand three hundred and thirty-six dollars (\$57,336) is the appropriation of a contribution from the Areawide Fund, Public Transportation 2005 Operating Budget (101) to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) to serve as the required local match.

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Section 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.

Subject: Authorization to enter into a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement

(TORA) between the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, and the Municipality of Anchorage, Public Transportation Department; and appropriating \$229,343 of (TORA) funds and \$57,336 of local funds to provide the required 20% local

match to the Grant to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231).

The purpose of this memorandum is to request Assembly approval for the Municipality of Anchorage to enter into a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) with the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to accept a grant to provide for Public Transportation Planning.

Under the provisions of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century, Federal Transit Administration (FTA) planning grants are awarded to the State of Alaska. Following the grant award from FTA, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, develops a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) which 'passes through' FTA funds to the Municipality of Anchorage. The Amount of the TORA will be \$229,343 (80%) for financing the Public Transportation Department Transit Planning Program. The required local match of \$57,336 (20%) is from existing Public Transportation Department's 2005 Operating Budget.

The grant supports the completion by the Public Transportation Department of the comprehensive and cooperative transit planning activities described in the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). This work will include a comprehensive route structure analysis, a planning review of system ridership and on-going People Mover planning issues. The period of performance will be from the award date until completion and no further obligation of funds may take place after 12/31/2007.

 The State of Alaska requires Assembly authorization to enter into the Agreement. Following receipt of the Assembly authorization, the State will give final signature on the Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement. In anticipation of this step, appropriation of the grant funds is incorporated into the Assembly Resolution. Processing of the supplemental appropriation into the Municipality's financial system will be held until receipt of the fully executed TORA from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.
