A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$90,000) FROM THE FEDERAL SEIZED AND FORFEITED MONIES FROM THE POLICE INVESTIGATION FUND (257) AWARDED FROM CRIMINAL NARCOTICS CASES BY THE U.S. DRUG ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, TO THE POLICE INVESTIGATION FUND (257) FOR USE BY THE ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$90,000) is appropriated from the Federal Seized and Forfeited Monies for use by the Anchorage Police Investigation Fund (257).

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Subject: Appropriation of Federal Seized and Forfeited Monies for the Anchorage Police Department (\$90,000)

The Anchorage Police Department requests appropriation of the sum of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000) to the Police Investigation Fund (257). This sum is from seized and forfeited monies that have been awarded to the Anchorage Police Department by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) through state and federal judicial proceedings as a result of joint DEA and Anchorage Police narcotics interdiction operations.

The United States Attorney General is authorized under asset forfeiture provisions of the Comprehensive Crime Control Act of 1984, the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986, Title 21 of the United States Code, and the Tariff Act of 1930 to transfer forfeited property. The transfer must be to local law enforcement agencies that participate directly in seizure or forfeiture of the property. The Attorney General exercises final authority over the official retention and transfer of forfeited property to local law enforcement and establishes the guidelines and limitations for its use.
