In March of 2005 the Municipality of Anchorage received a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities for a Drug Recognition Education Training program. This grant was intended to be used to provide Drug Recognition Expert education to five Traffic Unit officers during the period April 29, 2005 thru May 2, 2005. Due to staffing shortages in the department, the training will be performed in September 2005. Additionally, the State of Alaska has provided an amendment to this grant increasing the amount of reimbursement by \$3,000 to enable representatives of the department to attend the Eleventh IACP DRE Training Conference on Drugs, Alcohol and Impaired Driving.

This additional grant funding will be used to reimburse travel and lodging costs related to the DRE Training Conference that was held August 5-7, 2005 in Arlington, Virginia. Through increased awareness and enforcement of impaired driving violations, the citizens of Anchorage will experience safer roads and reduced traffic injuries.

A special condition of this grant amendment is that the department provides matching funds. The total projected Municipal cost is \$110, which has been budgeted in the 2005 Police Operating Budget. This grant began on April 29, 2005 and will end on December 31, 2005.
