RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL **ASSEMBLY** ESTABLISHING A POLICY THAT ENCOURAGES THE USE OF BICYCLE HELMETS AND PROMOTES THE ISSUANCE OF FREE BICYCLE HELMETS THROUGHOUT THE SAFE KIDS PROGRAM
