A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING TWENTY TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$22,125) FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS' AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) TO SUPPORT THE ANCHORAGE LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE (LEPC) ACTIVITIES.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of Twenty Two Thousand One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$22,125) be appropriated from the Department Of Military And Veterans' Affairs, Division Of Homeland Security and Emergency Management for use by the Municipality of Anchorage, Office of Emergency Management (231) fund.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Subject: Appropriation of \$22,125 from the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, for the State Fiscal Year 2006 as partial funding for the Anchorage Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC).

On October 17, 1986 Congress enacted into law the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) as Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA). SARA Title III establishes requirements that federal and state governments, local communities, and industry must implement regarding emergency planning and community right-to-know reporting on hazardous and toxic chemicals.

The Alaska State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) was formed pursuant to SARA Title III and Alaska Statute 46.13.010, as superseded by A.S. 26.23.071. The SERC designated the area encompassing the boundaries of the Municipality of Anchorage as the Local Emergency Planning District (LEPD) and established the Anchorage Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) within the district.

The Anchorage LEPC has established itself as an All-hazards LEPC, which provides the opportunity to apply for additional grant monies to address both hazardous materials and other hazards, natural or man-made, that may create an emergency situation in the areas that encompass the Municipality of Anchorage. On March 17, 2004, the Anchorage LEPC, by unanimous approval, assumed full responsibility to also function as the Citizen Corps Council of Anchorage for the purpose of encouraging citizen involvement and participation in supporting community safety. This award will provide partial funding to pay operating and equipment costs for the Anchorage LEPC staff.
