A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPROPRIATION OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO DOLLARS (\$1,744,792.00) FROM HERITAGE LAND BANK OPERATING FUND (221) BALANCE AS A LOAN TO THE ANCHORAGE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR PRE-DEVELOPMENT PROPERTY EXPENDITURES ON BEHALF OF FORMER HERITAGE LAND BANK PARCEL #3-012 LOCATED IN MT. VIEW.

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2005, the Anchorage Assembly approved AO 2004-181(S-1), establishing the Anchorage Community Development Authority (ACDA); and

WHEREAS, the Heritage Land Bank and ACDA were tasked by the administration to provide support for the Mt. View Arts and Cultural District and overall redevelopment of the Mt. View area; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2005, the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission approved HLBAC Resolution 2005-09, requested Assembly authorization to transfer HLB Parcel #3-012, legally described as Tract F, T13N, R3W, Sec. 16, SM, an approximately 25.7-acre parcel on Mt. View Drive, to ACDA, and on July 12, 2005, the Assembly approved AO 2005-85/AM 447-2005 approving the transfer; and

WHEREAS, per Anchorage Municipal Code subsections 25.35.060A.4. and A.5., ACDA has the power "To operate, manage and control municipal land and facilities in the authority inventory...To design, construct, improve, alter or repair municipal land and facilities in the authority inventory..."; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 25.40.035D., revenue in the Heritage Land Bank operating fund may be appropriated by the mayor "for acquisition of land for municipal use, and for improvements to Heritage Land Bank land."; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2005, the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission approved HLBAC Resolution 2005-15, requesting Assembly approval for a loan from the HLB Fund to ACDA of \$1,694,792.00 and up to \$50,000.00 for contingency costs as needed, totaling \$1,744,792.00, with reimbursement to the fund for all monies to occur at closing or no later than December 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, funds are available from the Heritage Land Bank Fund (221) Balance; now, therefore,

#### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The amount of One Million Seven Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars (\$1,744,792.00) is appropriated and provided as a loan from the Heritage Land Bank Fund to the Anchorage Community Development Authority for coverage of necessary pre-development costs to Tract F, T13N R3W, Sec. 16, SM, located on Mt. View Drive.

SUBJECT:A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPROPRIATION OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION, SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO DOLLARS (\$1,744,792.00) FROM THE HERITAGE LAND BANK OPERATING FUND (221) BALANCE AS A LOAN TO THE ANCHORAGE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR PREDEVELOPMENT PROPERTY EXPENDITURES ON BEHALF OF FORMER HERITAGE LAND BANK PARCEL #3-012 LOCATED ON MT. VIEW DRIVE.

Heritage Land Bank Parcel #3-012, legally defined as Tract F, T13N, R3W, Section 16, Seward Meridian, zoned I-2/SL, is a 25.67± acre parcel that was declared surplus to municipal use by municipal agency review in April, 2005, and comprises a major component of the redevelopment work currently proposed and underway for the Mt. View area.

The Administration was approached earlier in the year by a developer for a mixed use regional life-style mall concept with a residential component that was more appropriate for the Anchorage Community Development Authority to consider and pursue.

At its June 9, 2005 meeting, the HLB Advisory Commission authorized and recommended Assembly approval for the transfer of this parcel to the Anchorage Community Development Authority (ACDA), and on May 12, 2005, the ACDA board also approved acceptance of the transfer. On July 12, 2005, the transfer was approved by the Assembly to ACDA via AO 2005-85/AM 447-2005.

Due to various uses of the property in the past, the subject parcel is known to contain a number of contaminants that must be processed and removed before any development can occur. ACDA administration drafted cost estimates for required work to the property prior to the proposed development (See Appendix A). Those costs requested for coverage by a loan from the HLB Fund include an environmental site assessment, extensive site clean-up of the property, survey and replat costs as well as attendant legal and administrative costs to assist in the relocation of Public Works materials from the property. Some of these costs have already been borne by the Heritage Land Bank, and are slated for reimbursement upon completion of the project in addition to the requested loan.

On September 20, 2005, ACDA presented its proposal to the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission, requesting a loan of \$1,694,792.00 for anticipated pre-development costs on behalf of the subject parcel. The HLB Advisory Commission approved Resolution 2005-15, recommending Assembly approval for the appropriation of that amount from the HLB Fund, as well as an additional amount of \$50,000.00 for contingency purposes (Appendix B).

#### Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission Resolution #2005-15

A Resolution of the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission Recommending Assembly Approval for a Loan to the Anchorage Community Development Authority (ACDA) for Anticipated Pre-Development Expenditures on Behalf of the Former HLB Parcel #3-012 Located in Mountain View.

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2005, the Anchorage Assembly approved AO 2004-181(S-1), establishing the Anchorage Community Development Authority (ACDA); and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2005, the Heritage Land Bank Advisory Commission approved HLBAC Resolution 2005-09, authorizing the disposal of HLB Parcel #3-012 located in Mt. View to ACDA; and

WHEREAS, per AMC 25.35.060.4 and 5, ACDA has the power "To operate, manage and control municipal land and facilities in authority inventory... To design, construct, improve, alter or repair municipal land and facilities in the authority inventory..."; and

WHEREAS, the Heritage Land Bank and ACDA were tasked by the administration to provide support for the Mt. View Arts and Cultural District and overall redevelopment of the Mt. View Area; and

WHEREAS, the recent creation of ACDA preceded its ability to provide monetary support for improving property in its inventory and has requested a loan from HLB for initial predevelopment expenses on behalf of the former HLB parcel; and,

WHEREAS, funds are anticipated to be provided as reimbursement to the Heritage Land Bank Fund for said loan,

# NOW THEREFORE, THE HERITAGE LAND BANK ADVISORY COMMISSION RESOLVES TO:

- Section 1. Endorse the administration's efforts for the Mt. View redevelopment project designed to improve the general area, including other HLB properties.
- Section 2. Provide One Million, Six Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand, Seven Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars (\$1,694,792.00) from the HLB Fund Balance to the Anchorage Community Development Authority (ACDA) as a loan for pre-development costs incurred on behalf of the former HLB Parcel #3-012.
- Section 3. Require reimbursement of \$28,000.00 for ALTA survey costs, \$5,000.00 for legal fees and \$45,840.07 for Shannon & Wilson services, and such other costs previously expended by HLB on behalf of Parcel #3-012.
- Section 4. Authorization to provide an additional loan amount up to Fifty-Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) from the HLB Fund Balance, if needed, to complete the predevelopment project.
- Section 5. Reimbursement to the HLB Fund from ACDA of all monies as set out above will occur at closing or no later than December 1, 2006.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
