(\$248,000) from the Areawide General (101) Fund Balance as a contribution to the Development Services Department Building Safety (181) Fund, 2005 General Government Operating Budget, for bank fees,

overtime and contracted services.

AR 2003-394 approved January 6, 2004 appropriated \$299,000 from the Building Safety (181) Fund Balance as a contribution to three Dept ID's for the purpose of funding different projects as follows:

The replat for \$12,000 and the expansion of the PBX communications system for \$39,000 were accomplished. However, the paving of the south parking lot did not materialize and the \$248,000 funding designated for this purpose was never expended and lapsed into fund balance.

The accompanying Assembly Resolution is to give back the unexpended funds by reappropriating the \$248,000 as a contribution to the Development Services Department Building Safety (181) Fund, 2005 General Government Operating Budget.

Development Services requires additional funding to meet customer demand. Commercial construction is 58% of permits issued in 2005, a level unseen since 1983. Commercial permits require significantly greater resources to review and inspect, and the department has exceeded 2005 budget for plan review overtime and third-party plan review costs.
