A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING 1 THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$35.871) 2 FROM DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES AND INSURANCE RECOVERIES TO THE 3 AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101) TO BE CONTRIBUTED AND APOPROPRIATED 4 TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (485) AND 5 AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION 6 7 SECTION 5307 GRANT AND APPROPRIATING TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,287,200) FROM THE 8 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION 9 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (485) FOR THE PURCHASE OF CAPITAL ITEMS 10 AND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$288,000) FROM THE 11 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION ALONG WITH SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND 12 DOLLARS (\$72,000) FOR LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE PUBLIC 13 TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT'S 2005 **OPERATING** BUDGET AS 14 CONTRIBUTION TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241) FOR THE 15 AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) OPERATING ASSISTANCE AND 16 SHORT RANGE TRANSIT PLANNING. 17

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WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage periodically applies for and receives Federal Transit Administration grants for capital, operational and other purposes in connection with operation of its transit system; and therefore,

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The Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. That the Administration is authorized to accept a Federal Transit Administration Section 5307 grant.

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Section 2. That the sum of Two Million Two Hundred Eighty-seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$2,287,200) is hereby accepted and appropriated as a grant from the Federal Transit Administration to the Public Transportation Capital Fund (485) to fund the purchase of Public Transportation Capital Items.

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Section 3. The sum of Thirty-five Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-one Dollars (\$35,871) from disposal of vehicles and insurance recoveries is appropriated to the Areawide General Fund (101) and contributed to the Public Transportation Capital Fund (485) to fund the purchase of a vanpool replacement vehicle.

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Section 4. That the sum of Seventy-two Thousand Dollars (\$72,000) is contributed from the Public Transportation Department's 2005 operating budget, Areawide General Fund (101) to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241) to fund a transportation skills assessment center and travel training program for people with disabilities and for senior citizens and short range transit planning.

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Section 5. That a grant in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$288,000) from the Federal Transit Administration is appropriated to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Public Transportation Department, to fund a transportation skills assessment center and travel training program for people with disabilities and for senior citizens.

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Section 6. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Municipal Assembly of Anchorage.

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Appropriating the sum of \$35,871 from disposal of vehicles and vehicle accident recoveries and accepting and appropriating a Federal Transit Administration Section 5307 grant that provides Federal ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) operating assistance of \$248,000, planning assistance of \$40,000 and capital assistance of \$2,287,200 for the construction and purchase of capital items and fleet maintenance. The attached Assembly Resolution accepts and appropriates \$2,575,200 in Federal Transit Administration (FTA) operating and capital assistance. The total required local match is \$643,800. All of the required local match

has been approved and is ready for use.

The ADA assistance portion provides \$248,000 in grant funds with a required local match of \$62,000. The local match will be contributed from the Public Transportation Department's 2005 approved operating budget. This portion of the grant funds the operation of a Transportation Skills Assessment and Travel Training program to ensure transportation for the elderly and persons with disabilities is provided to them in a reasonable and cost effective manner. The planning assistance amount of \$40,000 in grant funds and \$10,000 in matching funds supports the short term planning functions of the Public Transportation Department. The local match will be contributed from the Public Transportation Department's 2005 approved operating budget.

The capital assistance portion provides \$2,287,200 in grant funds and requires local match of \$571,800. In-kind support to fleet maintenance will provide \$188,750. The remaining \$383,050 will be provided from 2005 General Obligations Bonds approved by voters in April 2005. The capital assistance funds preventive and capital maintenance items/vehicle overhauls, replacements of 10 paratransit and 8 vanpool vehicles, fleet improvements, automated operating systems, passenger shelters, IT hardware and software, and fleet support vehicles and equipment. The income from the sales of retired vehicles and accident recoveries provides the sum of \$35,871 for a vanpool van replacement.
