THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

16 In 1989 the Municipality accepted the donation of a group of four lots from the
17 Weyerhaeuser Mortgage Co. for park purposes (AR 89-27).

18
19 Until recently the property remained vacant except for natural vegetation, and
20 undeveloped. The property has a total area of .897 acres.



22 In the last two years the property has undergone significant improvement to
23 serve the surrounding neighborhood, and the property is now known as San
24 Antonio Park, for the principal adjoining street. Improvements include the
25 addition of playground equipment, picnic shelter, lighted pathway, and fencing.
26 Landscaping and further improvements are planned.

28 The Parks and Recreation Commission, at its meeting March 10, 2005,
29 recommended that this park be dedicated.




