7 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:
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9 **Section 1. Purpose.** The purpose of this Ordinance is to increase the number of active members on
10 the Youth Advisory Commission.

12 **Section 2.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.60.275 is hereby amended to read as follows (*other*
13 *parts of this section are not affected and therefore not set out*):

15 **4.60.275 Youth advisory commission.**

16 There is established a youth advisory commission consisting of 15 [9] members between 14 and
17 22 years of age whose terms shall commence July 1 and end midnight June 30, except as to members
18 appointed to fill an unexpired term.

22 **Section 3.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the

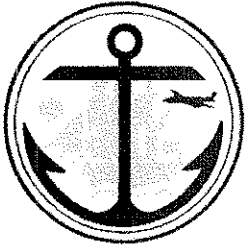

The Youth Advisory Commission (YAC) has unanimously approved a motion to request the expansion of the Commission from nine members to fifteen members. At present the Youth Advisory Commission is composed of nine (9) Anchorage youth between the ages of 14 and 22. In order to provide a more thorough representation of local youth the Youth advisory Commission recommends area representation based on the following parameters, resulting in an overall increase to 15 members.

This breakdown of membership was constructed to provide an accurate representation of youth in Anchorage, a diverse and growing city. Public schools were used because they divide youth geographically and allow different neighborhoods to be represented.

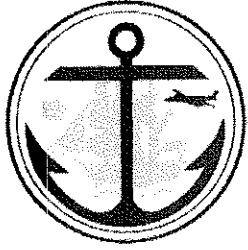
Youth from private and alternative schools were specifically designated so that the commission can gain input from students outside the realm of traditional public education. To ensure diversity of age a position was set aside specifically for a local university student. In order to maintain the flexibility needed in any organization three (3) positions will be left open to anyone fitting the specified age range.
