1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY
2 AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.97.030,
3 PROCEDURES FOR NAMING MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS, OTHER FIXED
4 FACILITIES AND PUBLIC PLACES, TO REQUIRE THE CITIZEN PANEL TO
5 INCLUDE AT LEAST ONE ASSEMBLY MEMBER AND ONE COMMUNITY
6 COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE DISTRICT IN WHICH THE
7 FACILITY IS LOCATED.

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10 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

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12 **Section 1:** Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.97.030 is amended to read:

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14 **3.97.030 Procedures.**

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16 A. Preliminary action in naming a facility may be initiated by the mayor or a
17 quorum of the assembly. If the assembly is the initiating organization, a proposal
18 in letter format addressed to the mayor will be prepared. Upon receipt of an
19 assembly request to name a facility or upon the mayor's decision to seek a name
20 for a facility, the mayor will appoint a five-member citizen panel subject to
21 assembly approval to review proposed names, to hold public hearings, and to
22 identify an appropriate name for the facility. The citizen panel may be composed
23 of members of recognized boards and commissions and shall include at least one
24 assemblymember and one representative from the community council in the
25 district that the facility is located.

2 **Subject:** AO 2005-136 – Naming of Municipal Buildings, Other Fixed Facilities and
3 Public Places.

5 The procedures set out in AMC 9.97.030 for naming municipal buildings and facilities were
6 enacted in 1987 and have not been amended subsequently. That section currently authorizes the
7 mayor to name a five-member citizen panel to review or identify appropriate names. These
8 citizens may be chosen from any part of the city and may be members of recognized boards or
9 commissions, but that choice is optional and at the discretion of the mayor. There is no provision
10 to include input from the community or neighborhood that is affected or the elected
11 representative of that district.

13 As set forth in AMC 2.40.020, the purpose of the community councils is to “to provide a direct
14 and continuing means of citizen participation in government and local affairs.” Enactment of
15 AO 2005-136 will ensure that buildings and facilities are named with the participation of
16 neighborhood representatives as well as their elected assembly member.
