ORDINANCE NO. AO 2006-6

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF FOUR MILLION FIFTY THOUSAND **DOLLARS** (\$4,050,000) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITY UPGRADES AND RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE ANCHORAGE PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA, AND THE QUESTION OF AN INCREASE IN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITATION TO PAY ASSOCIATED OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE COSTS AT AN ELECTION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ON APRIL 4, 2006.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska (the "Municipality") to incur general obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed FOUR MILLION FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,050,000) for purposes of paying the costs of repairing and upgrading recreational facilities, and related capital improvements throughout the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area.

Section 2. The sum of not to exceed Four Million Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$4,050,000) shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for the aforesaid capital improvements and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used only for payment of capital improvements and costs of issuance of the bonds. The full faith and credit of the

Municipality is pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property within the Municipality shall be levied without limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds when due. The principal of and interest on the bonds are to be paid first from general ad valorem taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area.

Section 3. An election is to be held on April 4, 2006, in and for the Municipality, for the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must receive a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting, both in the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area and areawide, on the question to be approved. The proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

PROPOSITION NO. __

ANCHORAGE PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA FACILITY BONDS

Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$4,050,000 through the issuance of general obligation bonds to pay the costs of repairing and upgrading recreational facilities and related capital improvements and related capital improvements and increase the municipal tax cap by an amount not to exceed \$224,400? The proposed capital improvements would be located within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area.

Voter approval of this bond proposition authorizes for each \$100,000 of assessed taxable property value (based on the estimated total 2006 assessed valuation in the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area): (i) an annual increase in taxes of approximately \$1.52 to retire the proposed bonds and (ii) an annual increase in the Municipal Tax Cap (Charter 14.03(b)(2) of approximately \$1.03 to pay for annual operations and maintenance costs related to the proposed capital improvements.

The debt shall be paid from real and personal property taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area. Anchorage will also pledge its full faith and credit for payment of the bonds.
