AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL OF A PORTION OF MIRROR LAKE/EDMONDS LAKE PARK TO EKLUTNA, INC., BASED ON FAIR MARKET VALUE BY EXCHANGE FOR A PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED ADJACENT TO MT. BALDY FOR TRAIL ACCESS TO CHUGACH STATE PARK.

WHEREAS, the northwest corner of Mirror Lake/Edmonds Lake Park is owned by the Municipality of Anchorage and, pursuant to AO 2000-115, is dedicated for park and recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, Eklutna, Inc. and the Municipality of Anchorage signed a Memorandum of Understanding to pursue an exchange of property of equal value to accommodate the location of a trail-head parking lot and trail corridor to Mt. Baldy in Chugach State Park; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Charter § 10.02(8) and Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30.020 require any disposal of land dedicated as public park to be approved at a regular municipal election by a majority of those voting on the question; and

WHEREAS, a companion ordinance, Anchorage Ordinance 2006-19, containing a ballot proposition as required by Anchorage Municipal Charter §10.02(8) and Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30020, has been submitted for voter approval at the April 4, 2006, municipal election, subject to approval of the disposal described herein; and

WHEREAS, if approved by the voters, the Municipality requests approval to dispose of approximately 20 acres, described as a portion of Section 35, Township 16 North, Range 1 West, Seward Meridian, located in the northwest corner of Mirror Lake/Edmonds Lake Park, by exchange for a parcel of land containing approximately 80 acres owned by Eklutna, Inc. as access to Mt. Baldy; and

WHEREAS, the Eklutna parcel, legally described as <u>Lot 4</u>, <u>Section 5</u>, and <u>Lot 1</u>, <u>Section 6</u>, both located in Township 14 North, Range 1 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, [S1/2, SW1/4, SEC. 32, T15N, R1W, SM, THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT, STATE OF






