AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 9.30.080, PARKING, TO REQUIRE BICYCLES TO BE PARKED SO AS NOT TO OBSTRUCT TRAFFIC.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 9.38.080, Parking, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.38.080 Parking.

Bicycles shall be parked so as not to obstruct traffic or pedestrians. [NO PERSON MAY PARK A BICYCLE UPON A STREET OTHER THAN UPON THE ROADWAY AGAINST THE CURB, OR UPON THE SIDEWALK IN A RACK TO SUPPORT THE BICYCLE, OR AGAINST A BUILDING OR AT THE CURB IN SUCH MANNER AS TO AFFORD THE LEAST OBSTRUCTION TO PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC.]

(CAC 9.38.080; AO No. 78-72; AO No. 80-4)

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
