8 **Section 1.** Anchorage Municipal Code section 9.38.080, Parking, is hereby amended to read
9 as follows:

11 **9.38.080 Parking.**

13 Bicycles shall be parked so as not to obstruct traffic or pedestrians. [NO PERSON MAY
14 PARK A BICYCLE UPON A STREET OTHER THAN UPON THE ROADWAY
15 AGAINST THE CURB, OR UPON THE SIDEWALK IN A RACK TO SUPPORT THE
16 BICYCLE, OR AGAINST A BUILDING OR AT THE CURB IN SUCH MANNER AS
17 TO AFFORD THE LEAST OBSTRUCTION TO PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC.]

21 **Section 2.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval
22 by the Assembly.
