1 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 14.60.030 FOR
2 CONSISTENCY WITH AO 2005-83(S) AS AMENDED.

5 WHEREAS, on August 30, 2005, the Assembly passed AO 2005-83(S) as amended, adopting Anchorage
6 Municipal Code (AMC) chapter 10.54 regarding licensing of towing operators in the Municipality and
7 amending section 10.05.025C. to add a fine for failure of a towing operator to comply with the licensing
8 requirement; and

10 WHEREAS, in order for the fine in section 10.05.025C., for failure to comply with licensing
11 requirements in chapter 10.54, to be assessed, it must also be set out in section 14.60.030; and

13 WHEREAS, inadvertently, AO 2005-83(S) as amended, did not amend section 14.60.030 to set out a fine
14 for compliance with licensing requirements in the new chapter 10.54; now, therefore,
