

ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AO No. 2006-56

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THE DEDICATED RIGHT OF WAY FOR 40TH AVENUE, LOCATED BETWEEN B STREET AND DENALI STREET, TO PERMIT DEVELOPMENT OF THE CUDDY FAMILY MIDTOWN PARK.

WHEREAS, a portion of the dedicated right of way for 40th Avenue bisects the presently partially developed Cuddy Family Midtown Park located adjacent to the Loussac Library, and

WHEREAS, the Cuddy Family is prepared and willing to donate funds to implement the master plan of the park including amphitheater access, accessible playground, landscape and garden areas, a speed skating oval with an active recreation area within the oval, centerpiece pond with promenade walkway and the Great Lawn and pavilion, but no such facilities can be built until the 40th Avenue right of way is vacated, and

WHEREAS, the Planning department and the traffic department support vacating the 40th Avenue right of way within the Cuddy Family Midtown Park; now, therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the requirements of Anchorage Municipal Code sections 21.15.030I., 21.15.125E., and 21.15.130D.3., the portion of 40th Avenue right-of-way located within the Cuddy Family Midtown Park, as more particularly shown on **Exhibit A**, is hereby vacated, and the use is redesignated as municipal parkland.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Municipality shall record a plat depicting the right-of-way vacation, and the area redesignated as parkland shall be named Tract A, 40th Avenue Park. Upon survey of the outer boundaries of the Cuddy Family Midtown Park, a new plat shall be recorded eliminating the right-of-way tract.

Section 3. Nothing herein shall vacate any existing utility easements.

<u>Section 4.</u> The vacation of the right-of-way described in this ordinance shall become effective when the Municipality records a right-of-way plat for Tract A, 40th Avenue Park, in substantially the form shown on **Exhibit A**.

<u>Section 5.</u> Except as provided in Section 4 above, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.




Costs associated with this vacation may include minimal staff time to prepare new plat map and a recorders fee of approximately \$25.00.
