AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 15.70 TO CLARIFY DEFINITIONS REGARDING NOISE.

THE ANCHOAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 15.70.030 is hereby amended to add new definitions and to revise definitions as follows (remaining definitions are not affected by this ordinance and therefore not set out):

<u>15.70.030</u> <u>Definitions.</u>

A. The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

*** *** ***

Construction means site-preparing, erecting, assembling, altering, installing, equipping, drilling, repairing, demolition or similar action on or of public or private rights-of-way, buildings, or utilities. For purposes of this chapter, construction is finite in duration. For the purposes of this chapter, modular house fabrication; asphalt or concrete production; sand or gravel extraction; truss manufacturing and other manufacturing are not construction when such activities occur at a location other than a construction site as defined in this section ASSEMBLY, ERECTION, PREPARATION, ANY SITE [MEANS SUBSTANTIAL REPAIR, ALTERATION OR SIMILAR ACTION FOR OR OF PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RIGHTS-OF-WAY, STRUCTURES, UTILITIES OR SIMILAR PROPERTY, BUT EXCLUDES DEMOLITION].

*** *** ***

Construction site means the location where site-preparation, erecting, assembling, altering, installing, equipping, drilling, repairing, demolition or similar construction on or of public or private rights-of-way, buildings, or utilities is being conducted or is taking place.

- Construction. No person shall engage in construction or cause or allow 3. construction INO PERSON SHALL OPERATE OR CAUSE THE ANY TOOLS OR EQUIPMENT USED IN OPERATION OF DRILLING, REPAIR, **ALTERATION** OR CONSTRUCTION, DEMOLITION WORK]:
 - So that the sound from the construction site [THEREFROM] creates a noise disturbance across a residential real property boundary or within a noise-sensitive zone between the hours of 10.00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. during the construction season, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. during other months, or at any time on Sundays or state holidays;
 - b. So that the sound level from the construction site [THEREFROM] exceeds an Leq of 80 dB(A) at or within a residential real property boundary or within a noise-sensitive zone during any one hour of the daily period from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. during the construction season or from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. during other months; or
 - So that the sound level from the construction site [THEREFROM] exceeds an Leq of 80 dB(A) at or within a commercial or industrial real property boundary during any one hour of the daily period from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. during the construction season or from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. during other months.

This S version clarifies the definition of "construction" and adds a definition for "construction site" only. These definitions specify which types of operations and activities are construction and which are not. Examples of construction are given as well as examples of manufacturing, including manufacturing that supports construction, that are not construction.

Within the municipal noise ordinance, construction is specifically addressed regarding generation of noise. Limits for noise levels from construction are higher than most other activities and construction is one of only five activities eligible for a noise permit. If applied for and granted, a noise permit may allow even higher levels of noise.

Many suggestions have been made by numerous people regarding the noise ordinance. Further meetings are planned with known stakeholders to discuss other code modifications necessary to meet current needs of the community.
