AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.70.040 TO RENAME THE SOLID WASTE COMMISSION TO SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING ADVISORY COMMISSION, AND TO UPDATE THE MISSION STATEMENT.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.70.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.70.040 Solid waste and recycling advisory commission.

There is established a solid waste commission consisting of seven members. The director of municipal solid waste services shall be the executive secretary and the technical advisor to the commission.

The commission shall:

- [CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARINGS ON MATTERS PERTAINING TO REFUSE [A.] COLLECTION, SOLID WASTE, HAZARDOUS WASTE AND RECYCLING RATES OR REGULATIONS, AND, AFTER SUCH HEARINGS, RECOMMEND TO THE MAYOR AND THE ASSEMBLY ADOPTION OF THE RATES OR REGULATIONS.]
- A.[B.] Review solid waste department policies and practices.
- [CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARINGS ON VARIOUS TOPICS RELATIVE TO SOLID WASTE, HAZARDOUS COLLECTIONS, WASTE RECYCLING SERVICES WHEN DEEMED ADVISABLE BY THE COMMISSION.]
- B.[D.] Review annually the solid waste department's budget and operations.
- C.[E.] Conduct public hearings when deemed appropriate on matters pertaining to refuse collection, solid waste, hazardous waste, recycling, composting, and waste reduction, including but not limited to, services, rates, regulations, and any [PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS AS TO ANY NECESSARY] expansion or improvement of the solid waste services department.

- <u>D.</u> <u>Make recommendations to the mayor and the assembly on the topics and issues reviewed by the commission.</u>
- E. Assist with public outreach and education on the topics of solid waste, hazardous waste, recycling, composting, and waste reduction.
- <u>F.</u> <u>Encourage economic development associated with waste management and materials recovery activities.</u>
- <u>G.</u> [F.] Perform such other duties as the mayor and the assembly may from time to time refer to the consideration of the commission.
