THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Anchorage Municipal Code section 21.45.080 is hereby amended to read Section 1. as follows:

21.45.080 Off-street parking requirements.

Standards for parking spaces; parking area design. Parking spaces Χ. provided in accordance with the requirements of this section shall meet the following standards:

Joint use. A single parking area may be used to serve more than 3. one establishment, provided that:

- The applicant shall show that the principal operating hours of the structures, buildings or uses for which the joint use of parking facilities is proposed do not overlap and the number of available spaces meets the requirements of this section.
- The parties involved in the joint use of off-street parking b. facilities shall submit a conformed copy of the written agreement for such joint use which has been [IN A FORM TO BE] recorded [FOR SUCH JOINT USE, APPROVED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICIAL AS TO FORM AND CONTENT]. If joint use of a single parking area is used to meet the number of parking spaces required by this section for more than one establishment, a[A]n agreement for joint use must be maintained [PARKING FACILITIES SHALL BEI for the life of the use of each establishment.
