AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 25, PUBLIC LANDS, TO ENACT A NEW CHAPTER, AMC 25.80, DELANEY PARK STRIP, TO REQUIRE ASSEMBLY APPROVAL OF SITE PLANS AND FACILITY DEVELOPMENT FOR DELANEY PARK STRIP, INCLUDING ALL MAJOR ADDITIONS, DELETIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code Title 25, Public Lands, is hereby amended to enact a new chapter 25.80 to read as follows:

Chapter 25.80 DELANEY PARK STRIP.

25.80.010 Purpose.

The Delaney Park Strip is the keystone park of downtown Anchorage, and one of Anchorage's most historic public places. The purpose of this chapter is to ensure that the Delaney Park Strip continues to contribute to the vitality of downtown Anchorage and to further ensure that the vision, goals and use policies for the Delaney Park Strip are developed and achieved with a consensus of our entire community, respecting Anchorage's unique diversity and community commitment and appreciation for family recreation and events, athletics, community gatherings, health and fitness, Anchorage's natural beauty, and the preservation of Anchorage's heritage and distinctive character as an Alaskan urban center.

25.80.020 Designation of Property.

The approximately 38-acre, 14 city-block strip of property, including Blocks 1 through 12, South Addition and Blocks 10 and 11, Third Addition, bordered on the north by 9th Avenue, on the south by 10th Avenue, on the west by P Street, and on the east by A Street, shall be known as the Delaney Park Strip, and is subject to the provisions of this chapter.

28.80.030 Review and Decision-Making Authority.

Any provision of this code or approved plan notwithstanding, the assembly shall have the final review and decision-making authority on all substantive or major site plans and facility development for the Delaney Park Strip, including without limitation, plans for the addition or deletion of sport fields, tennis or basketball courts, gymnasium facilities, ice-skating areas, major arboreal improvements, designated garden areas, memorials, walkways, trails, vendor or vehicular access areas, fountains or other aquatic improvements, residential or commercial development.

Section 2. The Office of Economic & Community Development, or other administrative unit designated by the mayor, shall submit to the assembly, through the chair, monthly quarterly updates with a comprehensive schedule of performance dates for completion of the Delaney Park Strip Master Plan, to be undertaken as part of the ANCHORAGE BOWL PARK, NATURAL RESOURCES, AND RECREATION FACILITY PLAN passed and approved by AO 2005-122 on April 18, 2006. Upon completion, the Delaney Park Strip Master Plan will be submitted in draft to the assembly for review and revision after public hearing before the assembly.

<u>Section 3.</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
