AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 28.50 TO ADD A NEW SECTION TO ESTABLISH A YOUTH ELECTION ASSISTANT PROGRAM.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Anchorage Municipal Code chapter 28.50 is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

28.50.015 Youth election assistant program.

- A. There is established in the Municipality the Youth Election Assistant Program.
- B. The municipal clerk may appoint one or more youths meeting the requirements of this section to serve as election assistants to the municipal clerk and the precinct election boards.
- C. To be considered for appointment by the municipal clerk to the Youth Election Assistant Program, a youth election assistant shall:
 - 1. Be a student age 16 or older, enrolled in a public or private high school program in the state, or being educated in the student's home by a parent or legal guardian in the state under AS 14.30.010(b)(12); and
 - 2. Successfully complete the orientation and instructional program prescribed by the municipal clerk.
- D. A youth election assistant appointed to assist a precinct election board under this section shall be supervised by the chair for the election board of the precinct.
- E. A youth election assistant appointed to assist the municipal clerk under this section shall be supervised by the municipal clerk or designee.

 F. A youth appointed to the program may be compensated for service as an election assistant to the municipal clerk or the election board of the precinct.

(GAAB 7.05.120, 7.05.180.B; CAC 2.68.300--2.68.330, 2.68.370, 2.68.390; AO No. 80-101; AO No. 84-139; AO No. 85-75)

This ordinance shall become effective on the date the United States Department of Justice issues its non-objection, or on the date by which the United States Department of Justice must object if no objection is issued within the objection period.
