Anchorage Municipal Code section 16.95.070 is hereby amended Section 1. by adding a new subsection B to read as follows:

> Basic life support (BLS) means transportation by <u>C.</u> ground ambulance vehicle, medically necessary supplies and services, plus the provision of BLS ambulance services.

 B. For *Municipality of Anchorage residents* [patients] receiving volunteer ambulance transport services from the Chugiak Volunteer Fire Department, the mileage fee and costs assessed to the patient for transport providing life support services under A.1. or A.2. of this section shall be reduced to an amount equal to their Medicare [er Medicaid] and/or other health insurance coverage.

PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

AFD transports approximately 1300 nonresidents annually leading to projected increase in revenue of \$130,000 for a \$100 nonresident fee. This would be offset by a projected decrease of \$13,000 for those bills generated by Chugiak transports. The net projected increase in revenues is \$117,000 per year. \$58,500 in increased revenue is estimated for 2009 with a half year implementation.

AFD would apply this \$117,000 increase to EMS nonlabor accounts to cover increased costs for medical supplies and new ongoing costs associated the new electronic patient care reporting system.
