HIGH SCHOOL RENEWAL PHASE 4

In accordance with AO No. 2000-106(S), this memorandum provides information required for submission and approval of the schematic design for Chugiak High School Renewal Phase 4. The revised design consists of final schematic design as defined by Municipal Code 25.25.610. This design was approved by the School Board on January 9, 2006.

Chugiak High School is located on a 50-acre site in Eagle River at the intersection of the Glenn Highway and Birchwood Loop Road. The 276,540 net square feet, two-story school delivers educational programs for grades 9 through 12. It was built in 1965 with additions and renovations in 1966, 1969, 1973, 1984, 1987 and 1989. In 2000 the current renovation project started. The Preliminary Plan (Conceptual Master Plan) design is based on an 1800 student High School. With the completion of Phases 1 through 4, the student capacity will be 1,817; current student population is approximately 1,500.

In November 2004, the voters approved funding in the amount of \$900,000 for design of Chugiak High School Phase 4. This project consists of the construction of House 4 and the common areas for the existing House 1. House 4 will consist of 9 general classrooms, 2 science classrooms, commons, offices and restrooms. The work on House 1 will add a commons, offices, restrooms, storage and a teacher center to the existing House. This project includes a new entry way, which after Phase 5 will be the main bus entry, and a courtyard with seating areas. The construction budget for the Phase 4 project is \$8,500,000. Subject to obtaining construction funding in April 2006, construction is scheduled to start in the summer of 2007 and is projected to be complete before August 2008.

The Schematic Design for the Phase 4 project is based on the Districtwide High School Educational Specifications adopted by the School Board on June 8, 1998, and the Chugiak High School Conceptual Master Plan and Supplement to the Districtwide High School Educational Specifications for Chugiak High School, approved by the School Board June 12, 2000 (ASD Memorandum #275 1999-2000). The School Board approved Bezek-Durst-Seiser as the design firm of record on April 13, 1998 (ASD Memorandum #260 1997-1999). The Municipal Assembly approved the selection of Bezek-Durst-Seiser on July 25, 2000, AR No. 2000-223.

49 50	The Building Design Committee (BDC), consisting of District Facility representatives, Chugiak High School staff, students, and administration met during the development of this Schematic Design. All concerns arising during BDC meetings have been considered in the Schematic Design.
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53	Bezek-Durst-Seiser delivered the Schematic Design submittal package to the School
	District on November 1, 2005. The Schematic Design floor plan, elevations and site plan
	drawings are included as Attachment A.


The Schematic Design Construction Cost estimate came in at \$8.75 million, \$250,000 over the construction budget for this project. This amount is within the range expected

for this level of design. Facilities will continue to work with the Architect and the BDC


to develop a project design that is within the previously established construction budget.


