A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, CONFIRMING AND LEVYING ASSESSMENTS FOR THE WATER SPECIAL IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN LEVY UPON CONNECTION (LUC) ROLL 05-W-3, SETTING DATE OF PAYMENT AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND INTEREST IN THE EVENT OF DELINQUENCY.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. As authorized by Anchorage Municipal Code (AMC) 19.90.010, assessments shall be levied upon those properties set forth on the attached assessment roll. These properties have connected to public water in accordance with provisions of AMC 19.90.020.

SECTION 2. Timely notice of assessment was sent to each property owner whose parcel is benefited by the improvements as indicated on the attached assessment roll. Each property owner was given notice of a Public Hearing to be held before the Municipal Assembly, providing an opportunity to present objections and/or inequalities regarding LUC Roll 05-W-3. In conformance with the notice to the property owners, the Municipal Assembly held a public hearing on ________, 2006. At said hearing all errors and inequalities to which valid objections were raised were corrected and the amounts now indicated on the assessment roll are those amounts determined to be assessed. Said amounts are equal to, or less than, the direct benefit each property derives from the improvements constructed. The assessment roll has been duly certified by the Municipal Clerk.

SECTION 3. Assessments shall be paid in annual installments, in accordance with the Anchorage Water Utility Tariff. The first installment is due by <u>May 31, 2006</u>, and is payable on the same day of each subsequent year. Interest on unpaid installments starts to accrue on <u>May 1, 2006</u>. An installment payment shall be applied first to accrued interest then to principal. A penalty of eight percent (8%) shall be added to any assessment, or assessment installment, not paid before the date of delinquency. The assessment, installment and penalty shall draw interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum until paid. For delinquencies, payment shall be applied in accordance with AMC 19.20.280.


A Special Assessment Collection Charges, as authorized in SECTION 4. 1 Section 13.4 of the Anchorage Water Tariff, will be charged to those properties 2 identified in this resolution. 3 4 Within thirty (30) days after the passage of this resolution, the SECTION 5. 5 municipal treasurer shall mail a notice to any owners of property whose assessment, 6 schedule of payments, delinquencies, or amount of penalty and interest has been 7 changed as a result of the public hearing concerning this resolution. 19.20.090 Public hearing--Notice.

Notice by publication and mail shall be given of any public hearing required in sections 19.20.020 through 19.20.080. Notice of the public hearing shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality at least once a week for two consecutive weeks prior to the time fixed for the hearing. The administration shall, at least 15 days prior to the hearing, send by first-class mail to each owner of property to be assessed, at his last known address, a written notice. The notice to be published shall include a summary of the improvement or service, the designation of the properties to be assessed in the special assessment district, the purpose of the public hearing, and the time and place fixed for the public hearing. The notice by mail shall include a summary of the service, the designation of the addressee's property to be assessed, the purpose of the public hearing, the amount of estimated or actual assessment or maximum millage rate against the property and the time and place fixed for the public hearing. Each notice shall generally inform the property owner of the manner and method of protesting or objecting to the action to be taken at the public hearing.
