

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FORTY TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$42,530) AS A GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME SOUTHEAST SUSTAINABLE SALMON FUND, TO THE PROJECT MANAGEMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT WITHIN THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANT FUND (231), FOR THE WATER QUALITY MONITORING AND EDUCATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has partnered with the Anchorage Waterways Council and the citizens of Anchorage to support water quality education and monitoring;

WHEREAS, fifteen monitoring stations are located on creeks eligible for salmon restoration support; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast Sustainable Salmon Fund will pay for 60% of the direct cost of proposed contractual expenses for a monitoring and education program targeted at creeks eligible for salmon restoration support; and

WHEREAS, the personnel cost for direct services will be provided by the Municipality of Anchorage Watershed Management Division; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has received a grant in the amount of \$42,530 from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game for the Water Quality Monitoring and Education Project; now therefore

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

 <u>Section 1.</u> That a sum of Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$42,530) in grant monies from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game be appropriated to the Project Management & Engineering Department within the State Categorical Grant Fund 231 for the Water Quality Monitoring and Education Project.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Education Project.

As partners with the Anchorage Waterways Council and the citizens of Anchorage, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game has granted the Municipality \$42,530 to support water quality education and monitoring to maintain the health of Anchorage creeks for salmon restoration.

The Stream Team program maintains fifteen monitoring sites located on Ship, Chester, Campbell and Little Campbell Creeks in Anchorage. Water quality education and monitoring are crucial to providing a healthy habitat for salmon, salmonid and macroinvertibrates.

This grant will provide 60% of the proposed contractual expense for monitoring stations that are located on creeks eligible for salmon restoration support, and for personnel costs for direct services provided by the Project Management & Engineering Department's Watershed Management Division. The Watershed Management Division is providing the necessary match to cover indirect costs not allowed under the grant agreement for Central Services costs.
