THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

That the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) is hereby appropriated as a donation from the Anchorage Park Foundation to the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area Capital Improvement Fund, (461) for the construction of a pavilion, sledding hill, and playground equipment at Abbott Loop Community Park.
