A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FIFTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$50,200) FROM A STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (ADOT&PF) FEDERAL HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE (MOA) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) UNDER THE MOA TRAFFIC DEPARTMENT FOR THE ANCHORAGE PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE/VEHICLE SAFETY PROGRAM.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$50,200) is hereby appropriated from a State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Federal Highway Safety Grant to the Municipality of Anchorage to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) under the MOA Traffic Department for the Anchorage Pedestrian/Bicycle/Vehicle Safety Program.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

**SUBJECT:** Appropriation of Fifty Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$50,200) From a State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Federal Highway Safety Grant to the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) Under the MOA Traffic Department for the Anchorage Pedestrian/Bicycle/Vehicle Safety Program.

An Assembly Resolution is requested to appropriate Fifty Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$50,200) from a State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Federal Highway Safety Grant to the Municipality of Anchorage to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) under the MOA Traffic Department for the Anchorage Pedestrian/Bicycle/Vehicle Safety Program. The local match of Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Dollars (\$9,840) will be expended with non-cash, in-kind personnel services from the Traffic/Safety Section operating budget.

The overall goal of the program is to reduce the annual number of pedestrian and bicycle accidents in the Anchorage area by at least 20% during the first year of the program. Phase One of the project, led by the MOA Traffic Department and ADOT&PF Safety Division, requires working with a consultant and a Project Advisory Committee to develop a pedestrian/bicycle/vehicle safety education and enforcement program. An ADOT&PF Pedestrian and Bicycle Collisions with Motor Vehicles in Anchorage Report will be utilized in the planning process. The education and enforcement program is scheduled to be developed by September 2006 for implementation. Phase Two, subject to future funding, implements Phase One recommendations through a prioritized approach.
