A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000) AS A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND APPROPRIATING SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$700) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE 2006 ANCHORAGE POLICE OPERATING BUDGET, ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA FUND (151) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) FOR THE PURCHASE OF TERRORISM RESPONSE AND PREVENTION EQUIPMENT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER AND THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000) is appropriated as a grant from the State of Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) for the purchase of terrorism response and prevention equipment.

Section 2. That the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$700) is appropriated from the 2006 Anchorage Police Operating Budget, Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151) as a contribution to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) for the purchase of terrorism response and prevention equipment.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

**Subject:** Appropriation of State of Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency  
Management State Homeland Security Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention  
Program Reallocated Funds (\$20,700)

The Municipality of Anchorage has received from the Office for Domestic Preparedness through the State of Alaska to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) reallocated Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program funding to enhance security and preparedness for terrorist prevention.

Grant funds awarded provide specifically for:

- Purchase of a Thermal Imaging Camera device
- Purchase of Night Vision Weapon Sights

The reallocated Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program Grant funds will be administered through a partnership between the Municipal Manager's Office, the MOA Emergency Operations Center and the Anchorage Police Department. A special condition of this grant is that the department contribute funds to support associated indirect grant costs. The total projected municipal cost is \$700 which is funded as a contribution from the 2006 Police Operating Budget. This grant began on May 5, 2004 and will end on April 30, 2006.
