Upon receiving this contribution, the Anchorage Park Foundation 16 17 launched the Clean & Green, Safe & Secure campaign with intent to upgrade the safety, function, and 18 appearance of several Anchorage parks. 19 20 In the summer of 2005, Anchorage Parks and Recreation logged 4,428 volunteer hours with 1,068 volunteers to Clean & Green 30 parks. Volunteers painted bollards, picnic tables, benches, and 21 22 kiosks. They cleared brush, weeded, removed trash, and replaced landscaping materials. The results 23 are a more involved community, better maintained parks, good media attention for the Anchorage Park Foundation, and substantially improved relationships with user groups. 24 25 Anchorage Parks and Recreation contracted with the firm of Land Design North to identify long term 26 27 and short term park improvement projects in 18 parks (see attached map) and establish design standards for many of the park amenities to be purchased with the initial Rasmuson contribution. 28 Parks and Recreation intends to spend this Rasmuson Foundation contribution, some municipal funds, 29 and a \$40,000 contribution from the Carr Foundation on amenities for parks in the summer of 2006. 30 Amenities will include such items as benches, trash receptacles and picnic tables, as displayed in the 31 32 November 2005 catalog. 33 34 Thank you to the Carr Foundation for investing in Pop Carr Park, and recognizing the value of community building. We hope this private investment for public good will be recognized and 35 celebrated by neighbors and families who will enjoy the beauty of our public spaces.
