Recommend that the Municipality of Anchorage accept Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) Amendments with the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) for Six Hundred Eighteen Thousand, Two Hundred Forty Three Dollars (\$618,243)

for enhancement of the Traffic Safety Database System

The purpose of this memorandum is to request Assembly acceptance for TORA Amendments with the ADOT&PF for the enhancement of the Traffic Safety Database System. This on-going project was deemed eligible for continued Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) support, and is to receive \$618,243 with a required local match of \$63,210 from the 2005 Traffic Capital Improvement Program (CIP). TORA amendments cover the next project phase, increasing FHWA support from \$653,356 (appropriated December 12, 2003 AR 2003-365) for a federal funding total of \$1,271,599. Requested appropriation will provide needed enhancements to the Accident Data, Traffic Volume Data, Traffic Studies, and Reporting Module portions of the System.

Project deliverables include several modules incorporated in two phases. The first phase utilizing previously appropriated grant funding, constructed the base system. The base system includes: hardware/software infrastructure, web interface, mapping capabilities, database configuration, core system setup, and the main accident module. The first phase of the project is nearing completion.

Funds from the requested appropriation will build upon the existing system and complete the project. This second phase will include system enhancements to: accident data, traffic volume data, traffic studies, and reporting modules. The second phase will also incorporate: code-required Annual Report statistics, safety analysis, data transfer, added user capabilities, improved GIS functions, and system upgrades for Municipal compliance.

Once complete, this web based system will integrate applicable traffic modules and information. It will incorporate new and old data currently housed in obsolete databases and within other manual systems. The new structure will join database information with mapping technology, and present it in a web accessible and public useable interface. This new system will be utilized by: transportation planners, public safety officials, engineers, consultants, insurance companies, attorneys, and the public at large. The presented data will also be used to fulfill Title 9 stipulations requiring an Annual Traffic Report.

Project funding will be used for contractual professional services for system enhancement and completion of the Traffic Safety Database System. The amended service contract will be requested in a subsequent Assembly memorandum.
