A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY THANKING THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE FOR RECOGNIZING THE NEEDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE THROUGH SUBSTANTIAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND OPERATING COSTS, AND REAFFIRMING THE ASSEMBLY'S COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE CITIZENS OF ANCHORAGE WITH PROPERTY TAX RELIEF.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has received record levels of recent income due to the high price of North Slope crude oil; and

WHEREAS, the wealth of Alaska should be shared with all of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the principle of sharing the state's wealth with all of Alaska's citizens and in further recognition of the needs of local governments and school districts, the Alaska Legislature has appropriated substantial funds for the Municipality of Anchorage, the Anchorage School District and other local governments;

NOW THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

- 1. The Anchorage Assembly thanks the Alaska State Legislature for recognizing the needs of the Municipality of Anchorage, the Anchorage School District and other local governments.
- 2. The Anchorage Assembly appreciates and thanks the Legislature for appropriating a very substantial amount of money for many needed capital improvements within the Municipality of Anchorage.
- 3. The Anchorage Assembly appreciates and thanks the Legislature for appropriating a substantial amount of money to pay for various operating costs of local government, including contributions to PERS/TRS, all of which will result in the reduction of property taxes imposed on local property owners.
- 4. The Assembly re-affirms its commitment to the citizens of Anchorage and to the Legislature that funds appropriated by the Legislature for operating expenses of the Municipality of Anchorage shall result in a dollar for dollar reduction to municipal revenues realized through real property taxes.
