1 A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY URGING THE
2 GOVERNOR OF ALASKA TO SUPPORT THE STATE LEGISLATURE'S RECOGNITION
3 OF THE NEEDS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, INCLUDING THE MUNICIPALITY OF
4 ANCHORAGE, THROUGH SUBSTANTIAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CAPITAL
5 IMPROVEMENTS AND OPERATING COSTS, AND REAFFIRMING THE ASSEMBLY'S
6 COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE CITIZENS OF ANCHORAGE WITH PROPERTY TAX
7 RELIEF.

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9 WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has recently received record levels of income due to the
10 high price of North Slope crude oil; and

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12 WHEREAS, the wealth of Alaska should be shared with all of its citizens; and

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14 WHEREAS, in recognition of the aforementioned, the Alaska State Legislature has
15 appropriated substantial funds for Alaska's local governments, including the Municipality of
16 Anchorage, the Anchorage School District, and the University of Alaska; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Alaska will review and exercise executive
19 discretion in these matters;

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21 NOW THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZES AND
22 RESOLVES:

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24 1. To strongly recommend the Governor endorse the Legislature's appropriation of
25 substantial funds for various operating costs of local government, including contributions
26 for PERS/TERS and energy assistance, which will result in the reduction of Anchorage
27 property taxes imposed on local property owners.

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29 2. To strongly recommend the Governor endorse the Legislature's appropriation of
30 substantial funds for many needed capital improvements within the Municipality of
31 Anchorage.

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33 3. To re-affirm its commitment to the citizens of Anchorage, to the Legislature, and to the
34 Governor that revenue sharing funds appropriated by the Legislature for operating
35 expenses of the Municipality of Anchorage shall result in a dollar for dollar reduction to
36 municipal revenues realized through real property taxes.
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1 4. To strongly recommend the Governor endorse the Legislature's recognition of the
2 needs of the Municipality of Anchorage, the Anchorage School District, the University of
3 Alaska, and other local governments.
