2 APPROPRIATING NINETY-SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS
3 (\$97,552) AS A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DIVISION OF PARKS & OUTDOOR
4 RECREATION, ALASKA TRAILS INITIATIVE GRANT PROGRAM, TO THE GIRDWOOD
5 VALLEY SERVICE AREA (406) FOR THE GIRDWOOD TRAIL PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE

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8 WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has transferred management authority of the Girdwood
9 Trail project to the Municipality of Anchorage; and

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11 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage applied for a 2005 State of Alaska, Alaska
12 Trails Initiative Grant to conduct design and maintenance of repairs to the trail's pedestrian
13 bridge; and

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15 WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Division of Parks & Outdoor Recreation, Alaska Trails
16 Initiative Grant Program has offered a grant of \$97,552 for bridge rehabilitation and resurfacing
17 now; therefore

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19 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

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21 Section 1. That the sum of Ninety-seven Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-two Dollars
22 (\$97,552) is hereby accepted and appropriated as a grant from the State of Alaska Division of
23 Parks & Outdoor Recreation, Alaska Trails Initiative Grant Program to the Girdwood Valley
24 Service Area (406) for the Girdwood Trail pedestrian bridge repair project.

Subject: Appropriation of \$97,552 from the State of Alaska Division of Parks & Outdoor Recreation, Alaska Trails Initiative Grant, for Pedestrian Bridge Repairs, Girdwood Trails Project, Project No. 05-34.

The accompanying Assembly Resolution is for the appropriation of \$97,552 in grant funds from the State of Alaska Division of Parks & Outdoor Recreation, Alaska Trails Initiative to the Girdwood Valley Service Area (406) for design and construction of repairs to the pedestrian bridge crossing the Alaska Railroad on the Girdwood Trail. This 1980s-era trail continues to be popular with the citizens of Girdwood and Anchorage as well as visitors who enjoy the 'Bird-to-Gird' trail. The trail is consistent with the Anchorage Areawide Trails Plan (1997) and is referred to as a key trail and an important link in the Girdwood Commercial Areas and Transportation Master Plan, 2001.

The Girdwood trail from Seward Highway to Crow Creek Road was built by the Alaska Department of Transportation in 1981, and a maintenance agreement was established with the Municipality. The existing trail and bridge surfacing, through wear and aging, is damaged to the point of being hazardous to users. This grant represents a cooperative effort by Anchorage Parks & Trails, Girdwood Board of Supervisors Trail Committee, and Girdwood Parks Department to acquire state funding to address hazards on the trail's pedestrian bridge.

Expenditures are approved from April 17, 2006 to August 31, 2008. The following budget is presented for Assembly information:
