Appropriation of 2005 and 2006 direct congressional appropriations to

the Municipality of Anchorage, totaling \$1,675,000, for hazardous fuels

removal and mitigation of wildfire risk.

The Administration requests appropriation of One Million Six Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,675,000) to the Anchorage Fire Department, Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), for hazardous fuels removal and mitigation of wildfire risk. These funds are administered as direct pass-through congressional appropriations by the United States Forest Service (USFS), State & Private Forestry.

The Municipality of Anchorage received its initial wildfire mitigation direct congressional appropriation in 2001. Annual appropriations have been included in all subsequent federal budget authorizations through 2006. To date, the Municipality has received a total of \$14,573,000 through six separate federal budget appropriations.

This appropriation request includes both the 2005 budget authorization of \$493,000 and the recently authorized 2006 budget authorization of \$1,182,000. The continuing focus of the department's wildfire mitigation program emphasizes the following four program areas:

- public land hazardous fuel load removal and mitigation;
- neighborhood and homeowner assistance programs;
- public education and prevention efforts;
- pre-positioning wildfire initial attack helicopter and fire suppression crew resources during periods of high fire danger; and

The requested expenditure budget provides for a set aside of \$300,000 in matching contributions to allow the Municipality to accept an additional \$100,000 grant from the United State Forest Service, State and Private Forestry, under the Cooperative Forestry Assistance Act of 1978, Forest Health Protection provisions. This use of federal funds to match other federal grant funds is possible because wildfire mitigation funds are direct congressional appropriations rather than program grants.

The Forest Health Protection and matching wildfire mitigation funds will be utilized to restore mixed hardwood forests in those open space and residential areas severely impacted by the Spruce Bark Beetle infestation.
