WHEREAS, the Southcentral Alaska Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) is a non-profit organization that is locally sponsored by the Volunteers of America, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, RSVP supports over 300 volunteers, 55 years of age or older, who help to provide valuable services to a wide variety of private and public non-profit agencies in the Anchorage and Mat-Su Valley; and

WHEREAS, RSVP is dedicated to building healthy communities by providing meaningful volunteer assignments and support to senior volunteers; and


WHEREAS, RSVP has over 140 workstations which include: 4'A's, Alaska Regional Hospital, Anchorage Senior Center, Anchorage Museum of History and Art, ACVB, Anchorage Pioneers' Home, Older Person's Action Group, Providence Hospital, The Salvation Army Older Alaskan's Program, Mat-Su Regional Medical Center, the MOA libraries, as well as the Wasilla and Palmer Senior Centers; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that in the year 2005, RSVP members volunteered 97,444 hours of service, valued at over \$1,700,000, which included activities that have contributed to the well being, safety, and improvement of the local community,


NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves that:
