1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING ONE  
2 HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$180,000) FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY  
3 MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO THE FEDERAL GRANT FUND (241), PROJECT MANAGEMENT  
4 & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, FOR THE WATERSHED MANAGEMENT DIVISION'S  
5 FLOOD HAZARD PROGRAM FOR FLOOD STUDIES IN THE GIRWOOD AREA AND  
6 ANCHORAGE AREA.

8 WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has offered the  
9 Municipality of Anchorage a grant of \$180,000 to provide funding to be used to perform flood  
10 studies on sections of Glacier and California Creeks in Girdwood and Furrow Creek in south  
11 Anchorage; and

13 WHEREAS, FEMA has granted the Municipality \$180,000 to cover 80% of the costs of the  
14 Flood Studies; and

16 WHEREAS, the necessary match is provided by the Watershed Management Division's  
17 general funding source; NOW THEREFORE,

19 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

21 SECTION 1. That a sum of ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS  
22 (\$180,000) in FEMA grant monies be appropriated to the Federal Grant Fund (241), Project  
23 Management & Engineering Department, to perform flood studies on sections of Glacier,  
24 California and Furrow Creeks.

26 SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and  
27 approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

SUBJECT: Resolution Appropriating a Federal Emergency Management Agency Grant to the Federal Grant Fund (241), Project Management & Engineering Department for Creek Flood Studies in the Girdwood and Anchorage Areas (\$180,000)

The Municipality has received a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to perform flood studies on sections of Glacier Creek and California Creeks in Girdwood and Furrow Creek in south Anchorage. The Project Management & Engineering Department will use competitively-awarded contracts for engineering services to develop detailed hydrologic and hydraulic analyses and floodplain and floodway mapping in these areas.

The selected engineers will deliver and incorporate into the digital flood insurance maps digital floodplain and floodway boundaries; digital profiles of the annual chance water surface elevations; floodway data tables; digital copies of all hydrologic and hydraulic modeling; and all backup data and reports used in the analyses or mapping.

The necessary match of \$46,000 will be provided by the Watershed Management Division's general funding source.
