WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has offered the Municipality of Anchorage a grant of \$180,000 to provide funding to be used to perform flood studies on sections of Glacier and California Creeks in Girdwood and Furrow Creek in south Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has granted the Municipality \$180,000 to cover 80% of the costs of the Flood Studies; and



The Municipality has received a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to perform flood studies on sections of Glacier Creek and California Creeks in Girdwood and Furrow Creek in south Anchorage. The Project Management & Engineering Department will use competitively-awarded contracts for engineering services to develop detailed hydrologic and hydraulic analyses and floodplain and floodway mapping in these areas.

The selected engineers will deliver and incorporate into the digital flood insurance maps digital floodplain and floodway boundaries; digital profiles of the annual chance water surface elevations; floodway data tables; digital copies of all hydrologic and hydraulic modeling; and all backup data and reports used in the analyses or mapping.
