2 GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED
3 FOURTEEN DOLLARS (\$103,914) FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DIVISION OF
4 ALASKA STATE TROOPERS, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW, STATE
5 CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231), FOR ADMINISTERING THE ANTI-GANG
6 INITIATIVE PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW, AND APPROPRIATING
7 TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$2,190) AS A
8 CONTRIBUTION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW OPERATING BUDGET FUND
9 (101) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231).

11 WHEREAS, the State of Alaska offered the Department of Law a grant for administration of
12 the Anti-Gang Initiative Program; and

14 WHEREAS, the Department of Law agrees to administer the Anti-gang Initiative Program to
15 meet the goals of both state and local interests, provided State funding is available; now
16 therefore,

18 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

20 **Section 1.** The sum of ONE HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED
21 FOURTEEN DOLLARS (\$103,914) is hereby appropriated from the State of Alaska, Division
22 of Alaska State Troopers, to state categorical grants fund (231) for administration of the Anti-
23 Gang Initiative Program in the Department of Law.

25 **Section 2.** The sum of TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS
26 (\$2,190) is appropriated from the 2006 Department of Law Operating Budget fund (101) as a
27 contribution to the state categorical grants fund (231) for the purpose of paying IGCs.

29 **Section 3.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval
30 by the Assembly.

Subject: A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FOURTEEN DOLLARS (\$103,914) FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DIVISION OF ALASKA STATE TROOPERS, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW, STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231), FOR ADMINISTERING THE ANTI-GANG INITIATIVE PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW, AND APPROPRIATING TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$2,190) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW OPERATING BUDGET, FUND (101), TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231).

The Department of Law is administering an Anti-Gang Initiative Program (Program). Four positions make up the Program – two attorneys, one secretary, and one clerk. The grant partially funds one attorney position.

The Anchorage Police Department (APD) documented Anchorage's growing gang problem. APD initiated a five-part program to aggressively prevent and crack down on gang violence. Some of the 40 new police officers added to the force in the past three years are focused on the problem of gangs and related crimes of guns and drugs. However, there is a growing backlog in the Alaska Court System in processing the cases. According to the District Attorney for the State of Alaska, there are more than 2,500 felony cases awaiting disposition in Anchorage, including many gang cases. Delays in processing mean the release of gang members into the community on bail.

Former U.S. Attorney, now U.S. District Court Judge Timothy Burgess recently proposed a partnership between the Municipality of Anchorage and the Office of the U. S. Attorney to help combat this problem. At Burgess' invitation, the Municipality proposes to assign the Program to the U.S. Attorney's office. The Program will be a staff specially trained in prosecution under federal laws, focusing primarily on gang-related crimes. Gang members prosecuted under federal law typically are processed more quickly, with more severe consequences, than under state law, removing gang members from Anchorage streets.
