A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$280,000) FROM THE FEDERAL OFFICE FOR DOMESTIC PREPAREDNESS, METROPOLITAN MEDICAL RESPONSE SYSTEM (MMRS) GRANT PROGRAM, TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241), OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR TRAINING, EQUIPMENT, MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND PUBLIC EDUCATION TO ENHANCE EMERGENCY RESPONSE TO MASS CASUALTY INCIDENTS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$280,000) is hereby appropriated from The Federal Office of Domestic Preparedness to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Office of Emergency Management, for training, equipment, medical supplies, and public education to enhance emergency response to mass casualty incidents.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Subject: Appropriation of The Federal Office of Domestic Preparedness to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Office of Emergency Management, for training, equipment, medical supplies and public education to enhance emergency response to mass casualty incidents.

This Assembly Resolution appropriates Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$280,000) from The Federal Office of Domestic Preparedness to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Office of Emergency Management, for training, equipment, medical supplies, and public education to enhance emergency response to mass casualty incidents.

Funds will be used to provide advanced Incident Command System (ICS) training for Anchorage Type III incident management teams (IMT's), to enhance communication equipment used by first responders and the Emergency Operations Center during a mass casualty incident, to re-stock pharmaceutical caches used for initial field response during mass casualty incidents and to publish public information brochures to help citizens better prepare for all types of hazards.
