A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000) FROM MUNISTEPS PROGRAM REVENUE AS A DONATION TO THE MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (261), DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR FUTURE MUNISTEPS PROGRAM COSTS

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

**Section 1.** That the sum of \$2,380 is appropriated from the 2005 MuniSteps Program as a donation to the Miscellaneous Operational Grants Fund (261), Department of Health and Human Services for future MuniSteps Program costs.

**Section 2.** That a sum not to exceed \$2,620 is appropriated from anticipated revenue from the 2006 MuniSteps Program to the Miscellaneous Operational Grants Fund (261), Department of Health and Human Services for future MuniSteps Program costs.

**Section 2.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

**Subject:** Appropriation of funds for the MuniSteps Program.

The Department of Health and Human Services has received Two Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Dollars and Twenty-Eight Cents (\$2,380.28) revenue from the sale of pedometers during the 2005 MuniSteps Program and anticipates up to Two Thousand Six Hundred Nineteen Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents (\$2,619.72) in revenue from the sales of pedometers during the 2006 MuniSteps Program.

This appropriation request is for the purchase of pedometers and participation incentives. MuniSteps is a simple and fun 9 week, 10,000 steps a day walking program that uses a pedometer to help increase physical activity. This year the Program has been expanded to include participation of all municipal employees and their families.
