A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-DOLLARS (\$1,519,460) FROM THE 2 DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS' AFFAIRS, DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CONTRIBUTION OF EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY 4 FIVE DOLLARS (\$8,125) FROM AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101) FIRE DEPARTMENT 2006 OPERATING BUDGET, EIGHT THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$8,125) FROM ANCHORAGE 6 FIRE SERVICE AREA OPERATING FUND (131) FIRE DEPARTMENT 2006 OPERATING BUDGET AND SIXTEEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$16,250) FROM ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA FUND (151) POLICE DEPARTMENT 2006 OPERATING BUDGET, TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE WIDE AREA RADIO NETWORK PROJECT AND FOR EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS PLANNING. 12

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THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

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Section 1. That a grant in the amount of One Million Five Hundred Nineteen Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$1,519,460) be appropriated from the Department Of Military And Veterans' Affairs, Division Of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to the State Catagorical Grants Fund (231) for use by the Municipality of Anchorage, Office of Emergency Management.

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Section 2. That the sum of Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$8,125) from Area Wide General Fund (101) Fire Department 2006 Operating Budget, Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$8,125) from Anchorage Fire Service Area Fund (131) Fire Department 2006 Operating Budget and Sixteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$16,250) from Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151) Police Department 2006 Operating Budget, is appropriated as a contribution to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) for Intergovernmental Charges related to the purchase of Anchorage Wide Area Radio Network (AWARN) equipment and for emergency communications planning.

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Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

Subject: Appropriation of One Million Five Hundred Fifty One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty

Dollars \$1,551,960 from the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, Anchorage Fire Department and Anchorage Police Department as funding to purchase equipment for the Municipality of Anchorage Wide Area Radio Network project and for emergency communications planning.

The events of September 11, 2001 illustrated the critical nature of interoperable communications during an emergency. On that day, hundreds of first responders lost their lives. A major factor that contributed to their deaths was lack of interoperability between the New York police department and the New York fire department.

Similarly, the Anchorage Police Department and Anchorage Fire Department operate on disparate radio systems. These systems have reached the end of the functionality and need to be replaced. The Anchorage Wide Area Radio Network (AWARN) system will provide a common, interoperable radio system for all Anchorage first responders. This system will enable Anchorage to become fully compliant with Department of Homeland Security requirements for interoperability. Compliance with federal standards ensures that the MOA will be eligible for future Homeland Security grants.

The AWARN system is a multi-year, phased project that includes training, equipment, project management and infrastructure. The funds from this appropriation will be used towards the purchase of multi-cast repeaters for the AWARN project.

Homeland Security Program Grant funds will be administered by the Municipality of Anchorage Office of Emergency Management. A special condition of this grant is that the Municipality contribute funds to support associated indirect grant costs. The total municipal cost is \$32,500. Since Anchorage first responders will be the primary users of this system, the Anchorage Fire Service Area Operating Fund and Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund will equally share the costs of indirect charges. This grant concludes March 31, 2007.
