A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SIXTY ONE DOLLARS (\$175,161) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) UNDER AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO A TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT (TORA) BETWEEN THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ADOT&PF) AND PUBLIC FACILITIES AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE (MOA) FOR THE TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALIZATION PROJECT.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SIXTY ONE DOLLARS (\$175,161) is hereby appropriated from the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) under the Municipal Traffic Department for the Traffic Control Signalization Project.

<u>Section 2.</u> This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

SUBJECT: Appropriation of One Hundred Seventy Five Thousand One Hundred

Sixty One Dollars (\$175,161) to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) Under Amendment No. 2 to a Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) Between the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) and the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) for the Traffic Control Signalization Project.

The Federal Highway Administration Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program, through the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), makes funding available for project support of the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) needs. This on-going project was deemed eligible for continued support, and has been awarded funding in the amount of One Hundred Seventy Five Thousand One Hundred Sixty One Dollars (\$175,161) bringing the total project funding to Six Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Four Hundred Seventy One Dollars (\$655,471).

The Traffic Department is responsible for the operations and maintenance of all of the traffic signals in the Municipality, regardless of ownership. The Signal Operations Section of the Traffic Engineering Division in the Traffic Department is responsible for developing new signal timing programs, reviewing signal plans, evaluating traffic studies, coordinating construction timing, developing new signal standards, and developing new policies and procedures for signal operations and maintenance. This funding will continue to be utilized to fund two staff positions in that Section.

The required match of Eighteen Thousand Sixty Dollars (\$18,060) will be funded in the Traffic CIP. This TORA is effective through December 31, 2008.

TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AMENDMENT TWO

The Transfer of Responsibility Agreement (TORA) for the Traffic Control Signalization project, effective July 21, 2004, and amended April 28, 2005 is hereby amended to add FFY 2006 funding, to update the State's coordinator, to extend the project schedule, and to add a local match requirement. This multi-year project updates traffic signal timing, addresses intersection congestion, and improves air quality.

The TORA is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Page one, paragraph two the second sentence is hereby amended to read: "The State's coordinator for this Agreement is Mark Parmelee."
- 2. Page one, paragraph three the first sentence is hereby amended to read: "The amount of this agreement for the <u>Traffic Control Signalization</u> project is \$655,471.00 in available federal funding plus a local match of \$18,060.00. The local match includes an ICAP charge of \$673.00. Federal funding is the sum of 2004 funding, \$191,571; 2005 funding, \$288,739; and 2006 funding, \$175,161."
- 3. Page one, number three, the first sentence is herby amended to read: "Special account funding for the Municipality shall not exceed a total of **Six Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-One dollars** (\$655,471.00)."
- 4. Page seven, Appendix A., B. Project Schedule is hereby amended to read: "This TORA is in effect through December 31, 2008."

6. Page nine, a local match provision is added to Appendix B, B. Payment Schedule that applies beginning with 2006 funds, that reads:

Billing and Local Match Procedure (if applicable)

Municipal billings will include all expenditures for any given quarter. The Department will pay 100% of the quarterly expenditures and bill the Municipality for 9.03% for local match for that quarter. The billing will also include indirect costs (ICAP) on the local match portion for the quarter. The current ICAP rate is 3.87%. The ICAP rate is subject to change every state fiscal year.

7. All other provisions of the amended agreement remain in force.
