WHEREAS, the 2007 Action Plan was made available to the public on August 2, 2006, public testimony on said application and 2007 Action Plan was heard before the Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission on August 9, and written comments on the plan were accepted through September 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2006, the HAND Commission recommended by resolution that the Assembly approve the 2007 Action Plan, and a copy of that resolution is included in the attached 2007 Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly Resolves:

Section 1. The Assembly adopts the 2007 Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan as the general basis of a comprehensive approach to address the housing and community development needs of lower income residents and neighborhoods and the application for applicable federal grants.

Section 2. That the subject grants from HUD for the PY2007 allocation of CDBG funds in the amount of one million nine hundred forty-one thousand nine hundred ninety-two dollars (\$1,941,992) of 2007 CDBG entitlement, ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) of anticipated CDBG program income; the PY2007 allocation of HOME funds in the amount of one million eight thousand eight hundred forty-seven dollars (\$1,008,847) of 2007 HOME entitlement and the PY2007 allocation of ADDI funds in the amount of twenty-five thousand four hundred eighty eight dollars (\$25,488), are hereby appropriated to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Department of Neighborhoods, PY2007 funding contingent on final approval by HUD anticipated in December 2006.

Section 3. That the subject grant from HUD for the PY2007 allocation of ESG funds in the amount of eighty-three thousand one hundred sixty-eight (\$83,168) is hereby appropriated to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Department of Health and Human Services, contingent on final approval by HUD anticipated in December 2006.

<u>Section 4.</u> That the allocation of said grant funds will be based on the activities outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum, and in the 2007 Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan. Accounting information is outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum, Attachment A.

Section 5. That a grant not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) of CDBG funds is awarded to Rural Alaska Community Action Program for the Homelessness Case Management Pilot Project for the second year funding as outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum and the 2007 Action *Plan*, and subject to availability of PY2007 CDBG public service funds. Total award over two years for this project will not exceed \$90,000.

Section 6. That a grant not to exceed one-hundred twenty-six thousand five hundred dollars (\$126,500) for second year funding is awarded to Alaska Legal Services for the Children at Risk Project, as outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum and the 2007 Action Plan, and subject to availability of PY2007 CDBG public service funds. The total award over two years for this project will not exceed \$253,000.

That a grant of one hundred thirty-two thousand five hundred eighty-one dollars 1 2 (\$132,581) for second year funding is awarded to Anchorage Literacy Project, as outlined in the attached Assembly Memorandum and the 2007 Action Plan, and subject to availability of PY2007 3 CDBG public service funds. The total award over two years for this project will not exceed 4 5 \$265,162. 6 7 Section 8. Subject: Adoption of the Consolidated Housing and Community Development 2007 Annual Action Plan (2007 Action Plan) and appropriating program income, Program Year (PY) 2007 entitlement grants for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), American Dream Downpayment Initiative (ADDI), and the Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241) making CDBG awards to Alaska Legal Services, Anchorage Literacy Project, Rural Alaska Community Action Program, and the Salvation Army for CDBG public service grants, in accordance with the 2007 Action Plan.

 The purpose of the attached resolution is to adopt the *Consolidated Housing and Community Development 2007 Annual Action Plan (2007 Action Plan)* and appropriate program income and Program Year (PY) 2007 entitlement funds. The *2007 Action Plan* constitutes the Municipality of Anchorage's application for U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) entitlement funds for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), American Dream Downpayment Initiative (ADDI) and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG). The *2007 Action Plan* is the fifth of five (5) annual action plans as part of the *2003-2007 Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan)*.

The 2007 program year begins on January 1, 2007. The 2007 Action Plan will be submitted to HUD after approval by the Assembly, and HUD may review the 2007 Action Plan for 45 days before final approval. PY 2007 entitlement funds identified in this document are based on anticipated grant awards as HUD has not yet released the actual 2007 entitlement award amounts. Consequently, all PY 2007 entitlement amounts are contingent on actual awards as announced by HUD, and actual award amounts may require return to the Assembly for appropriation of additional funds.

The 2007 Action Plan outlines an agenda of activities to be undertaken during 2007 to address needs of the Municipality's lower-income residents and identifies potential resources available in the community to undertake these activities. The 2007 Action Plan was developed by DoN in collaboration with DHHS, the Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission and other organizations and private citizens. CDBG, ADDI and HOME grants are managed by the Department of Neighborhoods (DoN) of the Office of Economic and Community Development. The ESG grant is managed by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).

Consistent with federal regulations, a discussion for input on the 2007 Action Plan was held in advance of the draft, during the HAND Commission's regularly scheduled July 2006 meeting. The availability of the draft 2007 Action Plan for public comment was noticed through the Anchorage Daily News on July 28 and through an electronic mailing on August 2. Comments were taken inperson during a public hearing on August 9, and written comments were accepted through September 1, 2006. All comments were considered in the final draft of the plan and in the HAND Commis-

sion recommendation. Section 1.4 of the final draft of the plan includes summaries of the comments received, together with responses to each comment. A copy of the final draft of the plan is included as Attachment B to this Memorandum.

The Department of Neighborhoods, Office of Economic and Community Development, requests approval of the attached resolution to appropriate program income and CDBG, HOME, ADDI and ESG entitlement funds with the 2007 Action Plan. Details on the sources and uses for each of these grants are included in the tables below. Additional descriptions of each activity are included in the 2007 Action Plan, Appendix A.

Second year funding for four CDBG Public Service grants as listed in the above table are proposed in this Memorandum. All other awards to outside organizations have been previously approved or will be brought to the Assembly at a later date.

Three of the public service grants (5.a., 5.b., and 5.d.) were the result of a competitive Request for Grant Proposals (RFGP) released in the Fall of 2005 by the DHHS. Proposals received were evaluated by staff for eligibility, ranked by an evaluation team consisting of members of the HAND Commission, the Health and Human Services Commission, and other community volunteers. Funding in 2007 under the RFGP process represents the second "optional" year of the two year grant award.

The first grant award funded under this RFGP process is to Alaska Legal Services for the Children At-Risk Project located at 1016 West 6th Avenue. This project includes direct and immediate legal assistance to families with children at risk of abuse or neglect due to various factors including domestic violence, poverty and homelessness. This award funds the second year of a two-year grant. The prior year award for 2006 was for one hundred twenty-six thousand five hundred dollars (\$126,500). This award shall not exceed one hundred twenty-six thousand five hundred dollars (\$126,500) in 2007, for a total award over two years not to exceed two hundred fifty-three thousand dollars (\$253,000), contingent on the availability of funds, as outlined in the 2007 Action Plan.

 The second grant award funded under this RFGP process is to the Anchorage Literacy Project for the Multi-Sensory Instruction for Illiterate Adults Project located at 1345 Rudakof Circle, #104. This project provides literacy skills to illiterate adults, including multi-sensory reading instruction in small classes supported with computer assisted learning software. This award funds the second year of a two-year grant. The prior year award for 2006 was for one hundred thirty-two thousand, five hundred eighty-one dollars (\$132,581). This award shall not exceed one hundred thirty-two thousand five hundred eighty-one dollars (\$132,581) in 2007, for a total award over two years not to exceed two hundred sixty-five thousand one hundred sixty-two dollars (\$265,162), contingent on the availability of funds, as outlined in the 2007 Action Plan.

The third grant award funded under this RFGP process is to the Salvation Army Cares for Kids Project located at 3710 E 20th Avenue. This project provides short-term emergency respite care for children (age birth through 11) to high risk families without charge. This award funds the second year of a two-year grant. The prior year award for 2006 was for twenty-three thousand nine hundred ninety-eight dollars (\$23,998). This award is for 2007 and is not to exceed twenty-three thousand nine hundred ninety-eight dollars (\$23,998), for a total two-year award not to exceed forty-seven thousand nine hundred ninety-six dollars (\$47,996). The 2007 award may be increased up to one hundred eighteen thousand seven hundred forty-four dollars (\$118,744) should additional CDBG public service funds become available in 2007, for a total grant award over two years of up to one-hundred forty-two thousand seven hundred forty-two dollars (\$142,742); however, all additional funding for this project is contingent on the availability of PY2007 CDBG public service funds, as outlined in the 2007 Action Plan.

The final public service grant listed in the table above was identified in response to Action Step 2.1.b of the Ten-Year Plan on Homelessness, adopted by the Assembly in January of 2005. This grant award is to Rural Alaska Community Action Program's (RurAL CAP's) Community Bound program. This pilot project provides funding for a case manager dedicated to individuals in the homeless camps with the highest negative community impact assisting them into housing. This award funds the second year of a two-year grant. The prior year grant award was executed in September of 2006 for the 2006 program year for forty thousand dollars (\$40,000). This 2007 award is for fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), for a total two-year award not to exceed ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000), contingent on the availability of funds, as outlined in the 2007 Action Plan.
