1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING TEN
2 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) FROM THE U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE GRANT
3 PROGRAM TO THE PROJECT MANAGEMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT WITHIN THE

6 WHEREAS, healthy streams provide the community with the benefits of flood control,
7 pollution attenuation, storm water conveyance, recreational opportunities, and wildlife and fish
8 habitat; and

10 WHEREAS, healthy streams and other waters of the United States is the goal of the
11 Municipality of Anchorage's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit program; and

13 WHEREAS, intact stream banks are a vital component of healthy streams; and

15 WHEREAS, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has granted the Municipality \$10,000, to
16 initiate a stream bank restoration program; and

18 WHEREAS, the necessary match is provided by the Salmon in the City Program; now,
19 therefore

21 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

23 SECTION 1. That a sum of TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) in grant
24 monies from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service be appropriated to the Project Management &
25 Engineering Department within the Federal Grant Fund (241) for initiation of a stream bank
26 restoration program.

28 SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and
29 approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

SUBJECT: Resolution appropriating a U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Grant to the Project Management & Engineering Department within the Federal Grant Fund (241) for initiation of a stream bank restoration program (\$10,000)

The Project Management & Engineering Department's Watershed Management Division received a grant of \$10,000 from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to initiate a stream bank restoration program. The necessary match of \$10,000 will come from the Municipal Salmon in the City Program grant funding.

The stream bank restoration program will promote stewardship of local streams and address local bank erosion and its effect on the benefits that natural streams provide: flood control, pollution attenuation, storm water conveyance, recreational opportunities, and wildlife and fish habitat. The program will encourage voluntary installation of bioengineered stream bank improvements through a community and municipal incentive program. The cumulative impacts from erosion will be reduced while enhancing habitat integrity. This program will also provide an outreach and education component for businesses and residents about stream stewardship and land use practices that preserve stream banks.

The grant period will end August 1, 2008. The accounting detail is as follows:
